Energy Conservation/Solar Powered Operations:

80% of Nile Safari Lodge runs on solar energy with 120 solar panels, ensuring your experience is both natural and environmentally responsible.

Water Conservation: We source water responsibly from the River Nile, treat it meticulously, and pump it seamlessly through our systems for use throughout Nile Safari Lodge.

Biodiversity Conservation: We proudly support the "Snares to Wares" youth anti-poaching programme. We buy wildlife sculptures made by youth, contributing to Murchison Falls National Park's protection.

Cultural Conservation: Experience local culture at Nile Safari Lodge with Adungu live band performances, community walks, and a gift shop filled with artifacts celebrating and preserving our unique cultural heritage.

Community Socio-Economic Wellbeing: Nile Safari Lodge dedicates 80% of staff to local communities, actively fostering sustainable practices through local purchases and craft development.

Sustainable Agriculture/On-site Greenhouse: Our on-site greenhouse cultivates organic herbs and vegetables, prioritizing environmentally conscious food production for a healthier supply in our kitchen.
