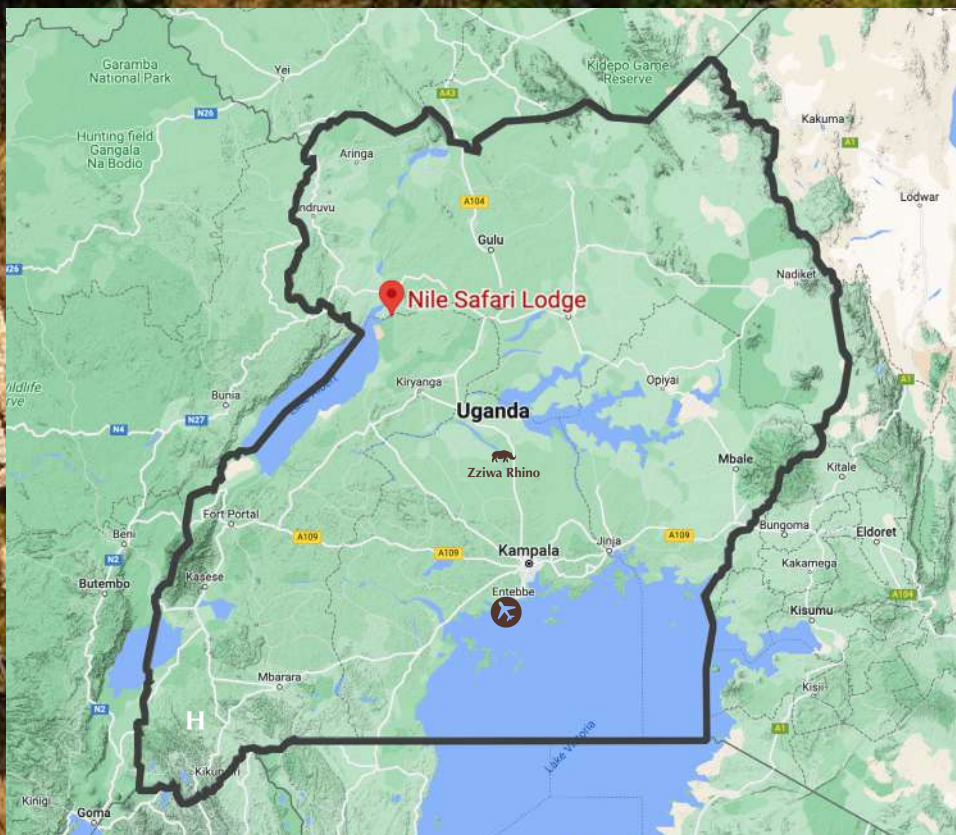

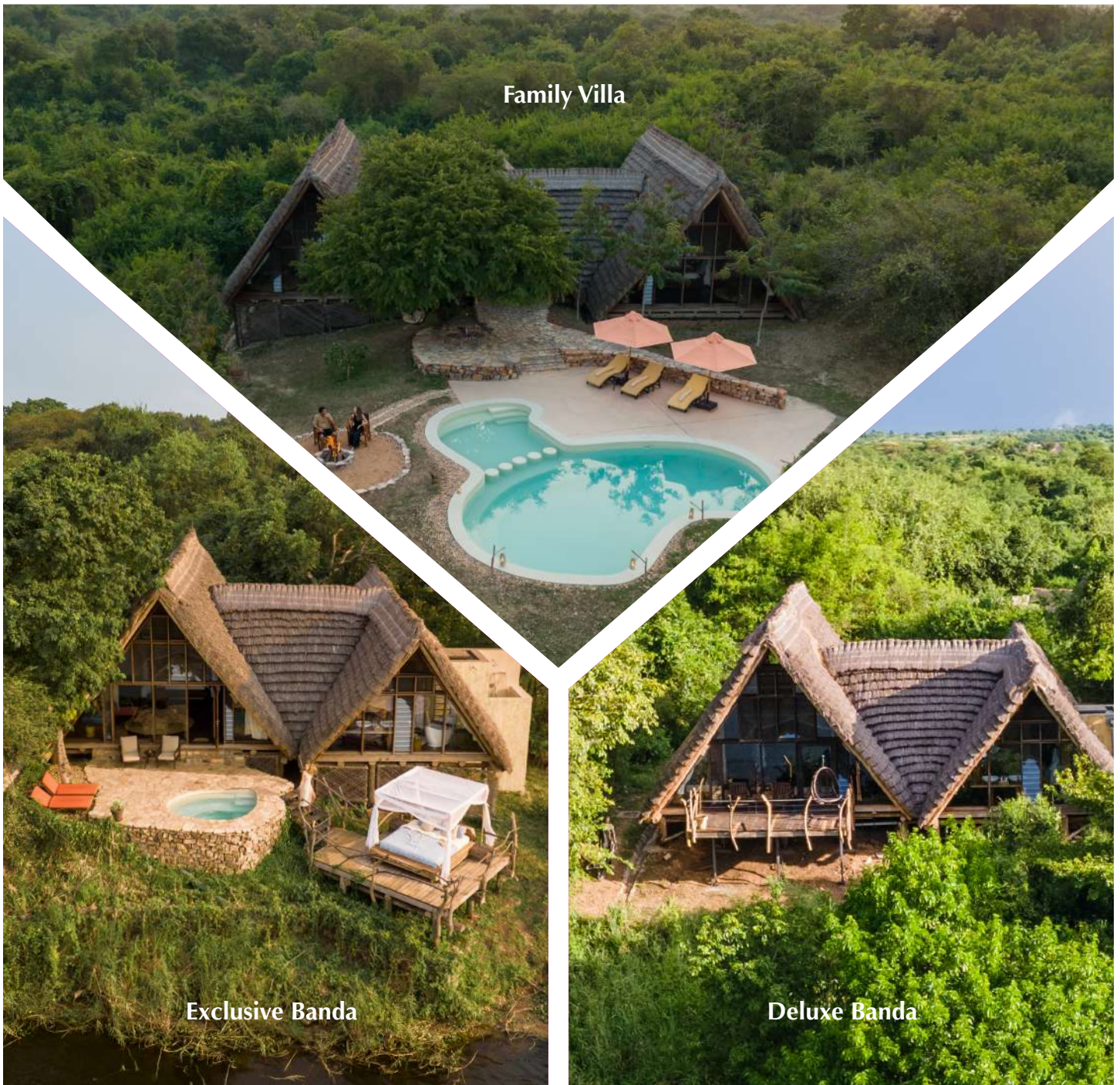

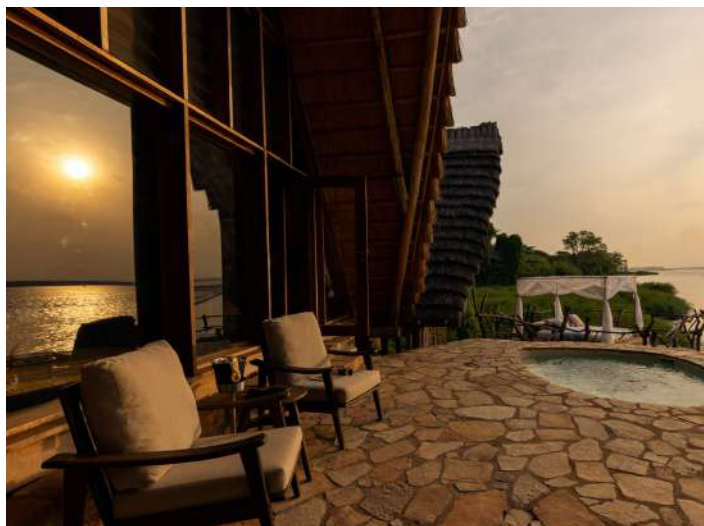

Murchison Falls National Park

Murchison Falls National Park is home to a diverse range of wildlife, including over 76 mammal species and 451 bird species. Covering an area of approximately **3,893 square kilometers**, it is Uganda's largest national park, offering exceptional biodiversity.

Visitors are guaranteed opportunities to spot and photograph four of the Big Five—lions, leopards, elephants, and buffalo. While rhinos are not present within the park, they can be observed at the nearby Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary.

Facts:

- Established in 1926 and designated as a national park in 1952, Murchison Falls National Park is Uganda's oldest and largest conservation area.
- It is best known for the dramatic Murchison Falls, where the **Victoria Nile plunges 45 meters** into the Devil's Cauldron
- The park is home to an incredible diversity of wildlife, including over **76 mammal species, 451 bird species, 51 reptile species and 51 amphibian species**.

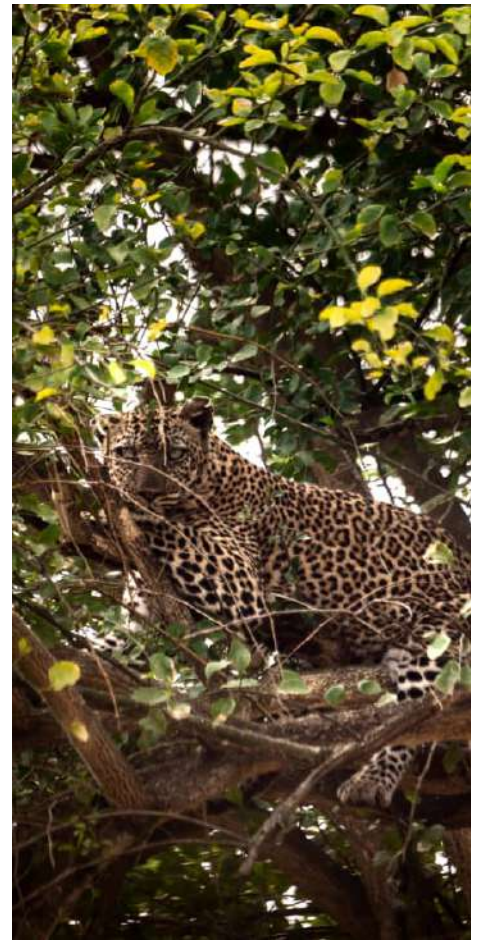

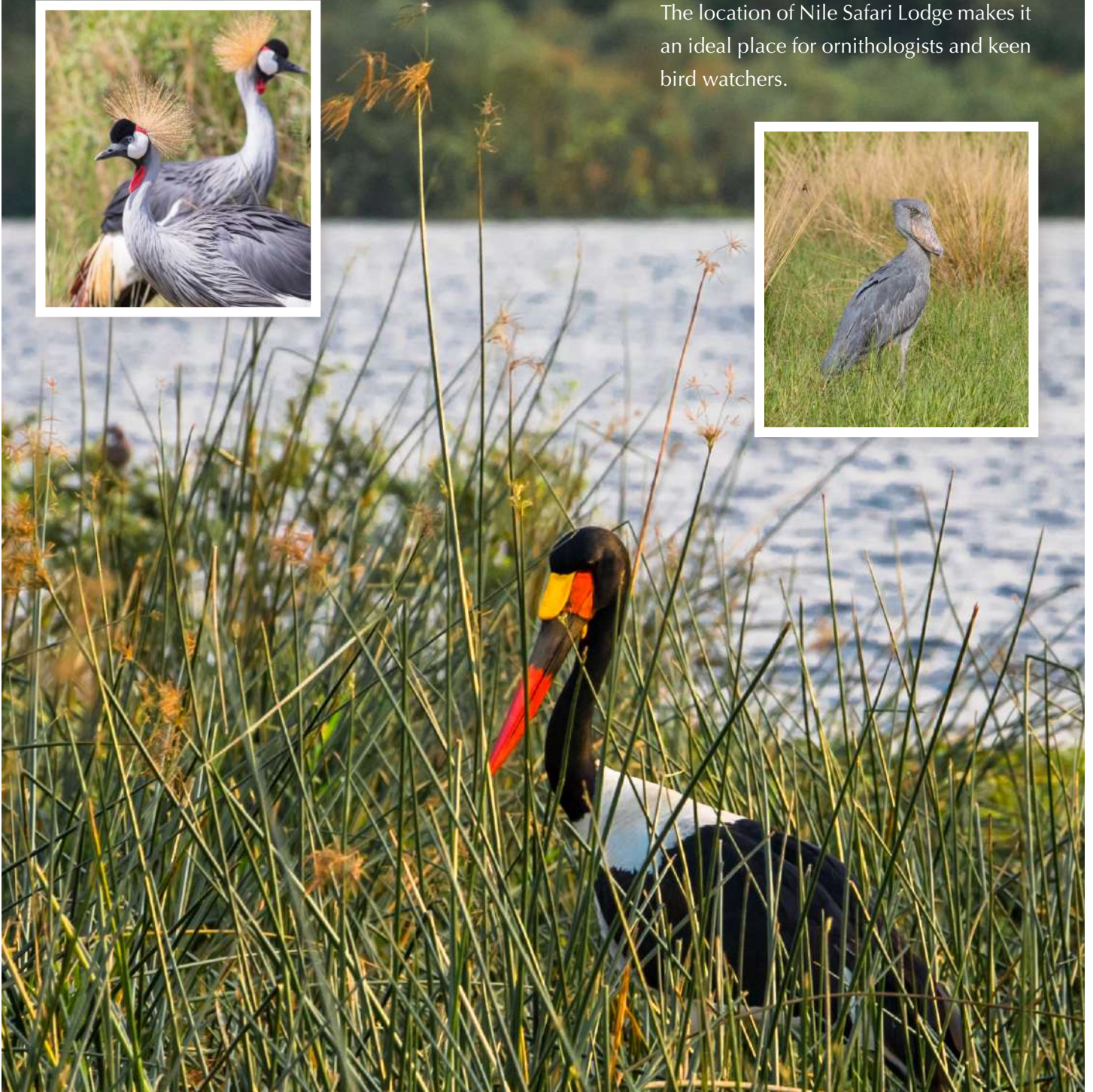

Home to over 1,100 species of birds, Uganda is a bird watchers' paradise. This includes Crested Crane, Abyssinian Ground Hornbill, African Fish Eagle, and the very shy majestic Shoe-bill Stork.

Budongo Forest - Chimpanzee Trekking

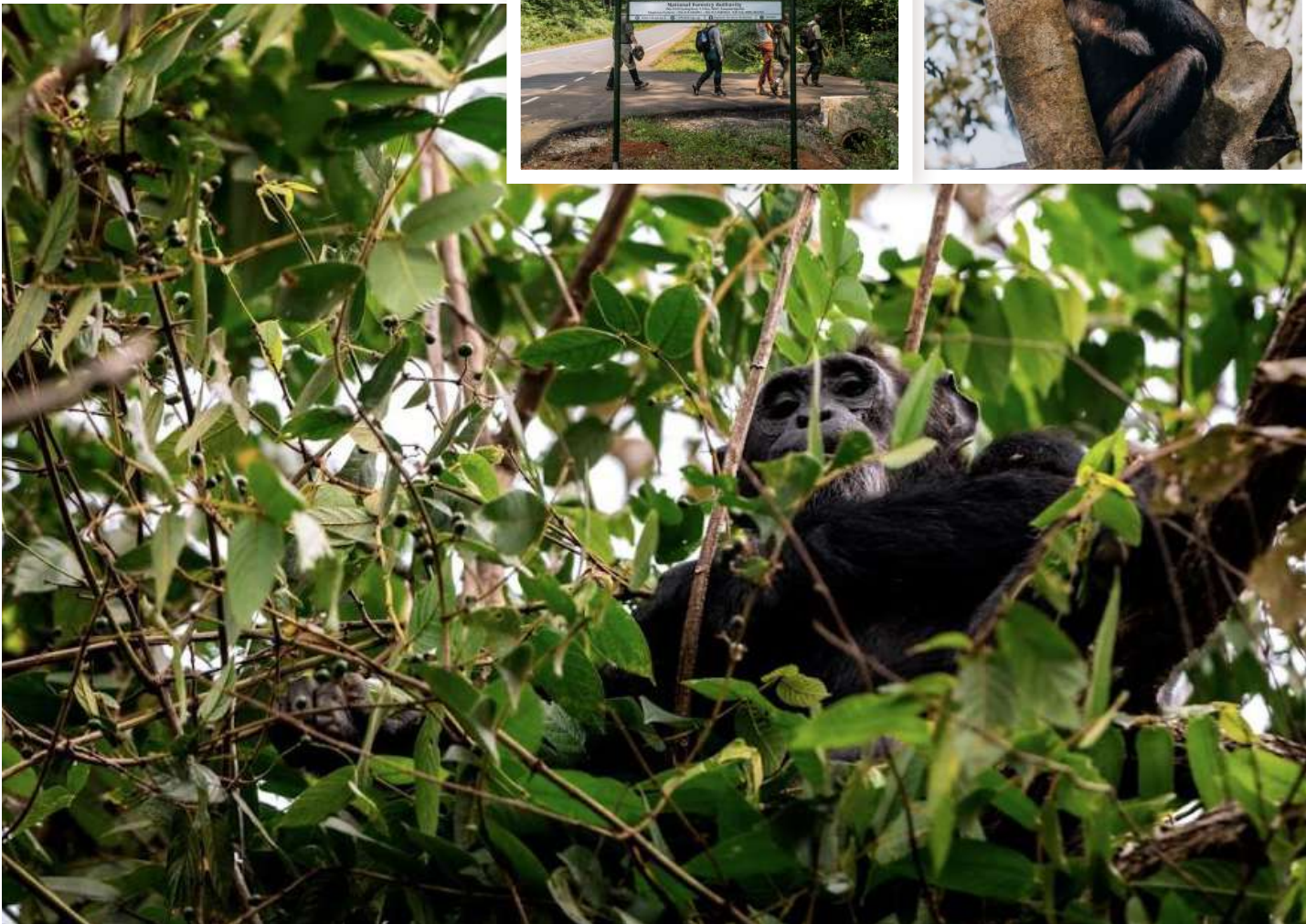
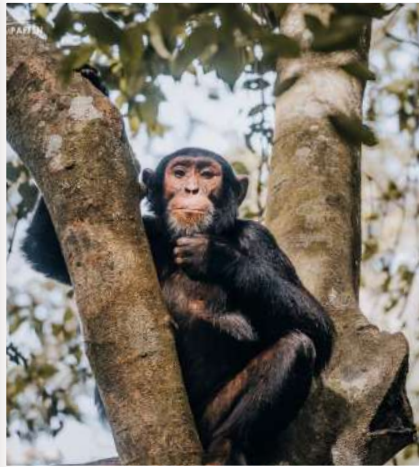
Uganda has a modest population of about five thousand chimpanzees distributed throughout the country, across various forests and game parks.

Budongo forest is the biggest Mahogany forest found in the whole of East Africa as well as being a habitat to the largest number of chimpanzees throughout Uganda. **Distance is 61Km from Nile Safari Lodge.**

Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary



The Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary is the only place to see rhinos in Uganda!

So if you're looking to complete your 'big five' game checklist you'll need to stop here. It is situated along the Kampala – Gulu highway approximately 180km by road; this is about halfway of the journey to Murchison Falls National Park.

This activity is a once in a lifetime opportunity and should not be missed! Only ^{USD} 55 per person and ^{USD} 25 for children below 12 years of age.

Facts:

- The Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary was established in 2005 with 6 southern white rhinos.
- By 2023, the Sanctuary had a total of **42 rhinos**.



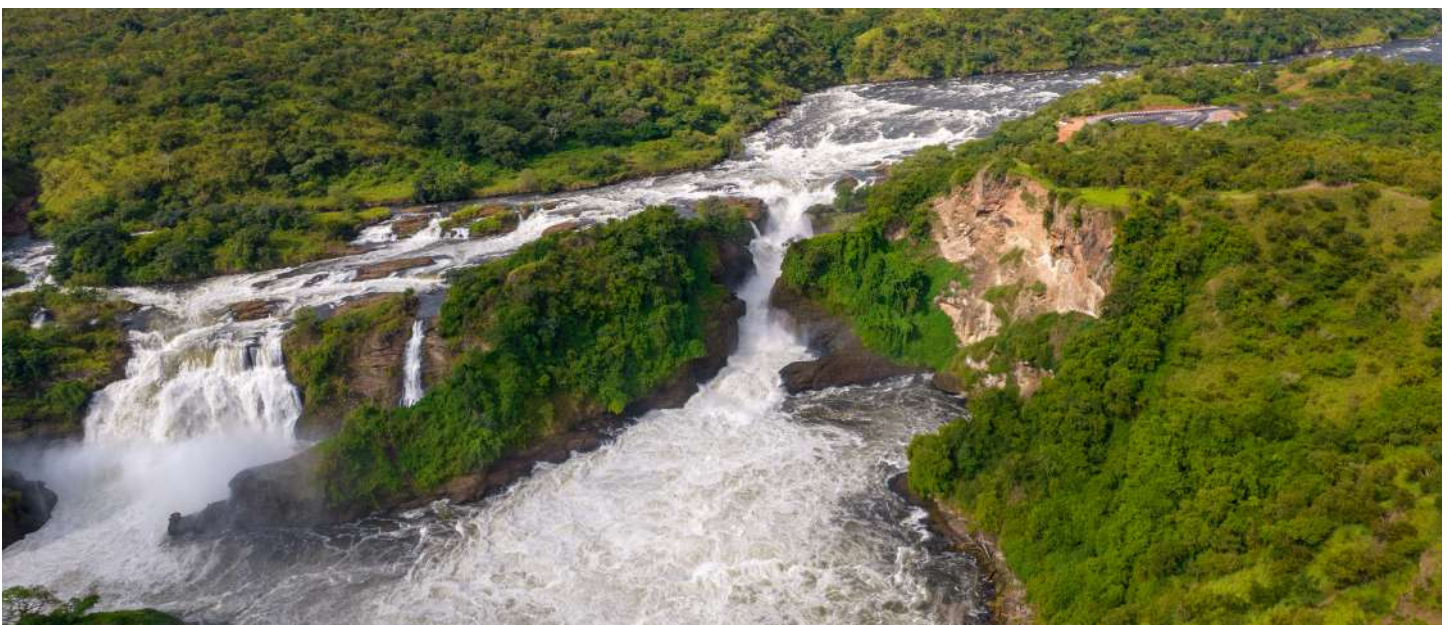
Murchison Falls Trek

Hiking to the top of Murchison Falls is one of the most exhilarating activities. It offers hikers a chance to watch the birds, and enjoy the breathtaking view the River Nile; and the spectacular scenery of Murchison falls National park. Drive to the top and start the hike from there.

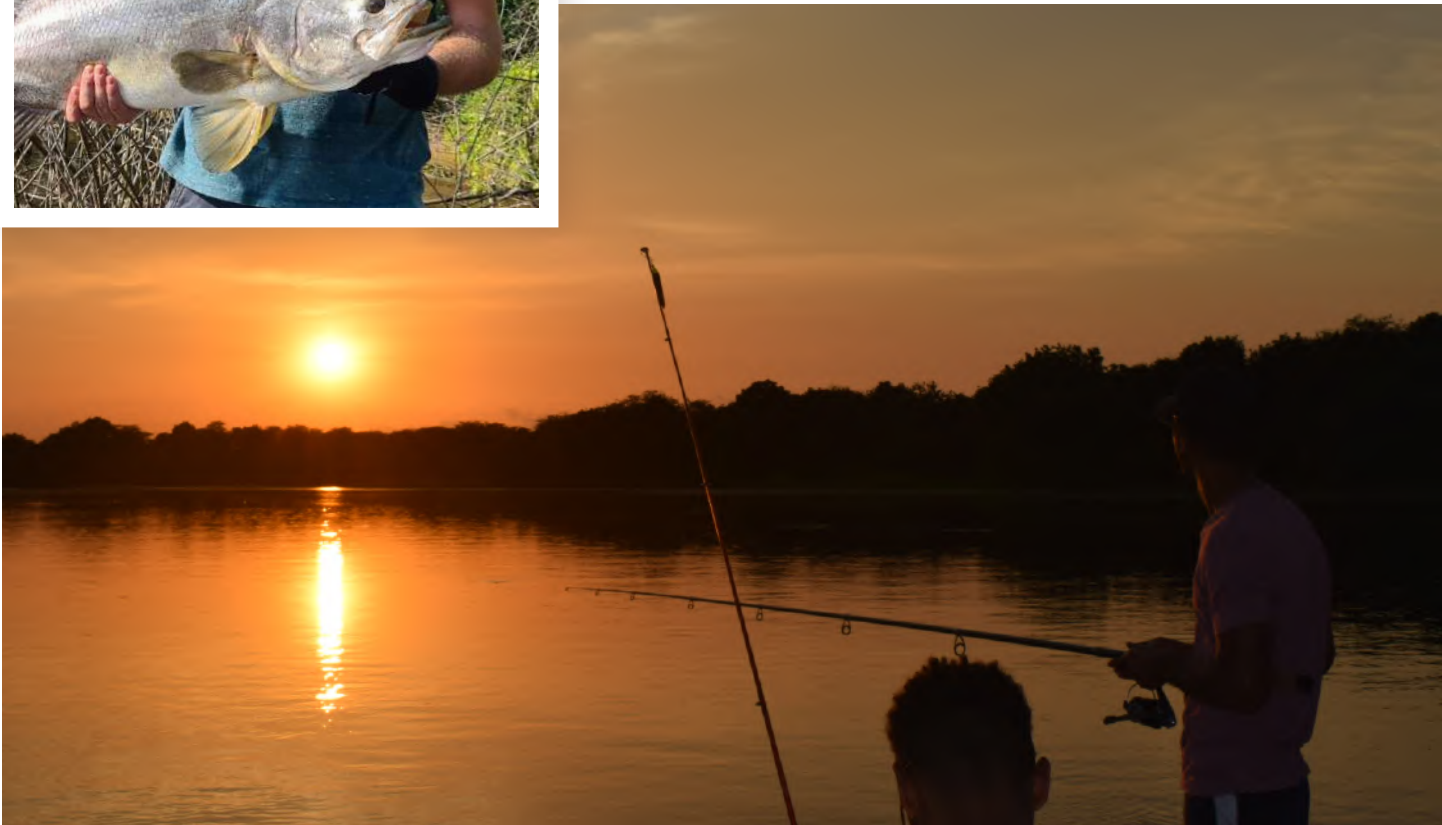

Vehicle Transfers

It will take you around 5 hours from Kampala to Nile Safari Lodge with an estimate of 300 km. Kampala – Masindi – Kichumbanyobo Gate – Mubako Gate (Via Park) - UWA Fees \$45 Per Person Per Day (Payment Accepted VISA & Mobile Money).

Transport from Kampala to the lodge is \$250 inclusive of fuel and driver.

Air Transfer

From Entebbe International Airport or Kajjansi to Murchison Falls National park there are several chartered flights that can be arranged in case you are interested. You can book domestic charter flights like Aero Link Uganda.

Air transport is easy and less tiresome, it is the best suitable option for visitors who are not used to travelling long distances. The closest Airstrip is Bugungu Airstrip, which is 25 minutes drive to the lodge, the other airstrip is Pakuba which is 40 min from the lodge.

80% of Nile Safari Lodge runs on solar energy with 120 solar panels, ensuring your experience is both natural and environmentally responsible.

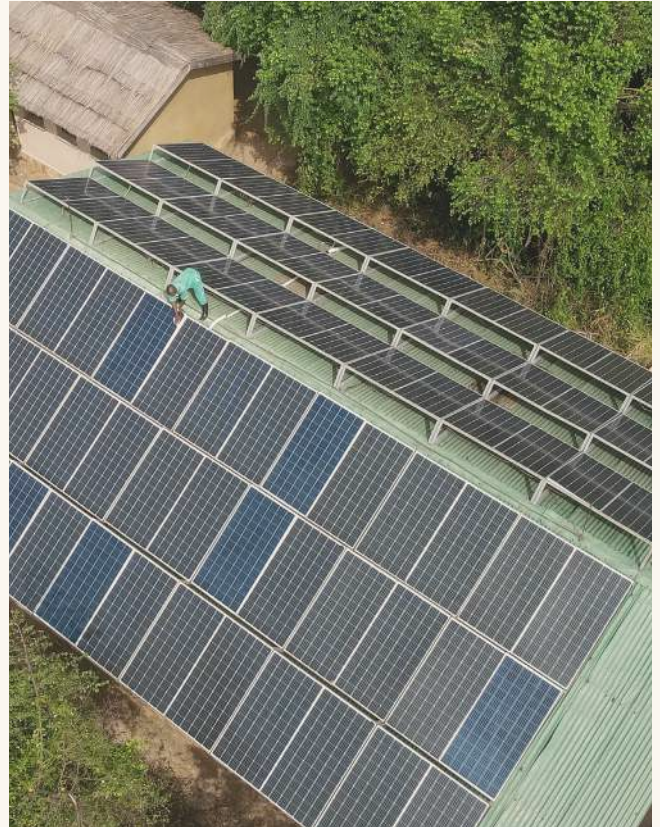
